

Fishery-Independent Surveys

The Pacific Islands Fisheries Science Center (PIFSC) is developing a Bottomfish Fishery-Independent Survey (BFISH) for Guam. BFISH is an annual, collaborative, public-private partnership between PIFSC and local cooperative research fishers to survey local bottomfish populations.


BFISH provides fishery-independent estimates of bottomfish abundance supporting annual stock assessments.

Surveying Bottomfish

The survey comprises two gear types:

- Cooperative Research Hook & Line fishing
- Stereo-cameras (MOUSS) deployed by NOAA Ships, Small Boats, & Cooperative Research Vessels.


Sampling locations chosen at random each year based on habitat type. During the survey period (August -November) fishing or camera gear are deployed for 30 minutes at each location. For both gear types, all fish caught or seen are recorded, counted, and measured. Biosamples collected for Life History.




Stratification & Optimization

BFISH employs a gridded, habitat-based, stratifiedrandom sampling design, comprising mapped bottomfish habitats at depths of 75 - 400 m around Guam

Iterative design refinement improved precision while reducing cost. Current composite design of ~500 samples achieves 15% CV target, yeilding 34-57% cost savings compared to earlier designs.




